Our Policy:

Welcome to the web site (the "**Site**") of 1080 Financial Group. ("**1080 Financial Group**", "we", "us" and/or "our"). This Site is operated by 1080 Financial Group and has been created to provide information about our company and our investment advisory and financial planning services (the "**Services**") to our users ("you", "your"). This Privacy Policy sets forth 1080 Financial Group's policy with respect to information including personally identifiable data ("**Personal Data**") and other information that is collected from Site visitors and users of the Services.

Information We Collect:

When you interact with us through the Site or the Services, we may collect Personal Data and other information from you, as further described below:

Personal Data That You Provide Through the Site: We collect Personal Data from you when you voluntarily provide such information such as when you register for access to the Services, use certain Services, contact us with inquiries or respond to one of our surveys. Wherever 1080 Financial Group collects Personal Data we make an effort to provide a link to this Privacy Policy.

By voluntarily providing us with Personal Data, you are consenting to our use of it in accordance with this Privacy Policy. If you provide Personal Data, you acknowledge and agree that such Personal Data may be transferred from your current location to the offices and servers of 1080 Financial Group and the authorized third parties referred to herein located in the United States.

Non-Identifiable or Aggregated Data: When you interact with 1080 Financial Group through the Site or Services, we receive and store certain personally non-identifiable information. Such information, which is collected passively using various technologies, cannot presently be used to specifically identify you. 1080 Financial Group may store such information itself or such information may be included in databases owned and maintained by 1080 Financial Group authorized vendors, agents or service providers. This Site may use such information and pool it with other information to track, for example, the total number of visitors to our Site, the number of visitors to each page of our Site, the domain names of our visitors' Internet service providers, and how our users use and interact with the 1080 Financial Group Site and Service. Also, in an ongoing effort to better understand and serve the users of the Services, 1080 Financial Group often conducts research on its customer demographics, interests and behavior based on the Personal Data and other information provided to us. This research may be compiled and analyzed on an aggregate basis. 1080 Financial Group may share this non-identifiable and aggregate data with its authorized vendors, agents and business partners, but this type of non-identifiable and aggregate information does not identify you personally. 1080 Financial Group may also disclose aggregated user statistics in order to describe our services to current and prospective business partners, and to other third parties for other lawful purposes.

In operating this Site, we may also use a technology called "cookies." A cookie is a piece of information that the computer that hosts our Site gives to your browser when you access the Site. Our cookies help provide additional functionality to the Site and help us analyze Site usage more accurately. For instance, our Site may set a cookie on your browser that allows you to access the Site without needing to remember and then enter

a password more than once during a visit to the Site. In all cases in which we use cookies, we will not collect Personal Data except with your permission. On most web browsers, you will find a "help" section on the toolbar. Please refer to this section for information on how to receive notification when you are receiving a new cookie and how to turn cookies off. We recommend that you leave cookies turned on because they allow you to take advantage of some of the Site's features.

Google Analytics:

We may use Remarketing with Google Analytics to advertise online, and may use the Remarketing feature of Google Analytics for Display Advertising. Third-party vendors, including Google, can display our ads on sites across the Internet. 1080 Financial Group and other third-party vendors, including Google, use first-party cookies (such as the Google Analytics cookie) and third-party cookies (such as the DoubleClick cookie) together to inform, optimize, and serve ads based on visitors' past visits to our Site. Visitors can opt-out of Google Analytics for Display Advertisers and customize Google Display Network ads using the Ads Preferences Manager at <http://www.google.com/ads/preferences>.

Our Use of Your Personal Data and Other Information:

1080 Financial Group uses the Personal Data you provide in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Policy. If you provide Personal Data for a certain reason, we may use the Personal Data in connection with the reason for which it was provided. For instance, if you contact us by email, we will use the Personal Data you provide to answer your question or resolve your problem. Also, if you provide Personal Data in order to obtain access to the Services, we will use your Personal Data to provide you with access to such services and to monitor your use of such services. 1080 Financial Group may also use your Personal Data and other personally non-identifiable information collected through the Site to help us improve the content and functionality of the Site, to better understand our users and to improve the Services. 1080 Financial Group and its Related Companies may use this information to communicate with you regarding the Services or to tell you about services we believe will be of interest to you. If we do so, each marketing communication we send you will contain instructions permitting you to "opt-out" of receiving future marketing communications. Note however that as a user of the Service you cannot opt-out of some administrative communications that are reasonably necessary to the Service, such as billing or service notifications. In addition, if at any time you wish not to receive any future communications or you wish to have your name deleted from our mailing lists, please contact your advisor directly or the Chief Compliance Officer as indicated below.

If 1080 Financial Group intends on using any Personal Data in any manner that is not consistent with this Privacy Policy, you will be informed of such anticipated use prior to or at the time at which the Personal Data is collected.

Our Disclosure of Your Personal Data and Other Information:

1080 Financial Group is not in the business of selling your information. We consider privacy and security of this information to be a vital part of our relationship with you. There are, however, certain circumstances in which we may share your Personal Data with certain third parties without further notice to you, as set forth below:

Business Mergers and Acquisitions: As we develop our business, we might sell or buy businesses or assets. In the event of a corporate sale, merger, reorganization, dissolution or similar event, Personal Data may be part of the transferred assets.

Authorized Technology Vendors: We will share certain Personal Data with authorized technology vendors that provide functionality and support critical to the operation of 1080 Financial Group's Site and Services. Examples of such functions include maintaining databases and financial planning software. When we work with another company to perform a function of this nature, we only provide them with the information that they need to perform their specific function.

Agents, Consultants and Third Parties: 1080 Financial Group, like many businesses, sometimes hires other companies to perform certain business-related functions. Examples of such functions include mailing information and processing payments. When we employ another company to perform a function of this nature, we only provide them with the information that they need to perform their specific function.

Legal Requirements: 1080 Financial Group may disclose your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to (i) comply with a legal obligation, (ii) protect and defend the rights or property of 1080 Financial Group, (iii) act in urgent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of the Site or the public, or (iv) protect against legal liability.

Your Choices:

You can use the Site without providing any Personal Data. If you choose not to provide any Personal Data, you may not be able to use certain Services.

Exclusions:

This Privacy Policy does not apply to any Personal Data collected by 1080 Financial Group other than Personal Data collected through the Site or Services. This Privacy

Policy shall not apply to any unsolicited information you provide to 1080 Financial Group through this Site or through any other means. This includes, but is not limited to, information posted to any public areas of the Site, such as blogs (collectively, "Public Areas"), any ideas for new Services or modifications to existing Services, and other unsolicited submissions (collectively, "Unsolicited Information"). All Unsolicited Information shall be deemed to be non-confidential and 1080 Financial Group shall be free to reproduce, use, disclose and distribute such Unsolicited Information without limitation or attribution.

Children:

1080 Financial Group does not knowingly collect Personal Data from minors under the age of 18. If you are under the age of 18, please do not submit any Personal Data through the Site. We encourage parents and legal guardians to monitor their children's Internet usage and to help enforce our Privacy Policy by instructing their children never to provide Personal Data on this Site without their permission. If you have reason to believe that a minor under the age of 18 has provided Personal Data to 1080 Financial Group through this Site, please contact us, and we will endeavor to delete that information from our databases.

Links to Other Web Sites:

This Privacy Policy applies only to the Site. This Site may contain links to other web sites not operated or controlled by 1080 Financial Group (the "Third Party Sites"). The policies and procedures we described here do not apply to the Third Party Sites. The links from this Site do not imply that 1080 Financial Group endorses or has reviewed the Third Party Sites. Security:

1080 Financial Group takes reasonable steps to protect the Personal Data provided via the Site from loss, misuse, and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.
